

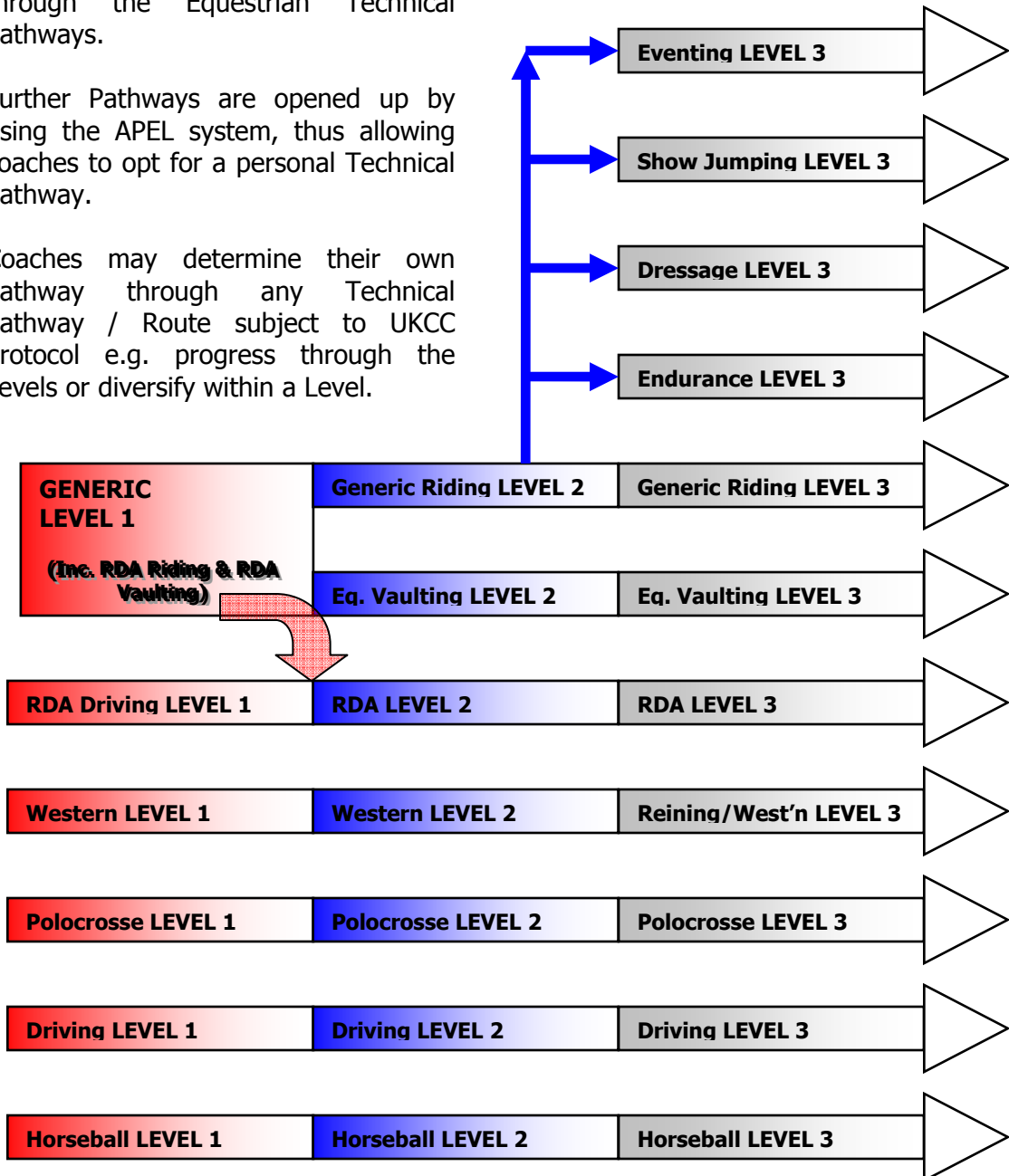
UKCC EQUESTRIAN

Technical Route Map

A representation of direct progression through the Equestrian Technical Pathways.

Further Pathways are opened up by using the APEL system, thus allowing coaches to opt for a personal Technical Pathway.

Coaches may determine their own pathway through any Technical Pathway / Route subject to UKCC protocol e.g. progress through the Levels or diversify within a Level.



THE BEF COACHING PATHWAY

Generic and Discipline Specific Progression

The table shows the breadth of pathways Coaches can pursue.

An Equestrian Coach Registering for a Level 3 Award will have come through Level 1 and Level 2 or have used the APEL system to access Level 3.

At Level 3 the Coach may continue on a Generic Pathway or diversify in any one of the other 11 discipline specific Technical Pathways.

Included in the submission are the Tutor Notes for Generic delivery and also for each discipline specific Technical Pathway.

Elements of the Learning Programme will be delivered generically and then examples and coaching practice drawn from the Coach's chosen discipline specific Technical Pathway, coaches will be assessed within the context of their chosen Technical Pathway.

Coaches may determine their own route through any Technical Pathway / Route subject to UKCC protocol e.g. progress through the Levels or diversify within a Level, move through their chosen route and achieve in more than one discipline specific Technical context.

For example, a Generic Riding Level 2 Coach may chose to pursue Generic Riding 3 or opt for any of the discipline specific Technical Pathways, e.g. Show Jumping. Their entry point would be measured via the APEL system. See below:
